- HB or 2B Pencil, eraser, pencil sharpener
- Set of soft, chalk pastels (24 - 48 colors)
- General's Compressed Charcoal 6B
- Canson Mi-Tientes Pastel Paper
- Tortillion(s) or blending stump (chamoix recommended)
