Watercolor

This class meets in Yosemite Village in front of the Yosemite Valley Visitor Center, at shuttle stops 5 and 9. Look for our signs! We'll meet outside and spend four hours creating art together in Yosemite Valley.

Please arrive between 9:30 AM and 9:45 AM to purchase your supplies (if needed) and get settled in. Class begins at 10 AM, when the group will head out to create art *en plein air*. ART SUPPLIES TO BRING

- HB or 2B pencil, vinyl eraser, and sharpener
- Watercolor paper, 140lb cold press (pad, block, notebook, or individual sheets)
- Watercolor brushes, 2 round (1 between #4 - #6 and 1 between #8 - #12) and 1 flat (¾"-1")
- Watercolor paints (pan set or tubes) – we recommend all primary colors (a warm and a cool hue of red, blue and yellow) as well as some earth tones (greens and browns)
- Mixing palette recommended

** Materials and supplies are available for **rent** through our registration process, or for **purchase** at the Yosemite Valley Bookstore at the Valley Visitor Center. When you register, please indicate if you will be bringing your own supplies, renting supplies, or purchasing a kit from us so we can prepare accordingly.

- Water bottle for drinking water
- Weather appropriate attire
- Sunscreen/hat
- Lunch/snacks (class does not break for lunch)
