And while its smooth shoulders and sheer face may seem impassive, Half Dome is a dynamic feature, shifting with the light, humming with plant and animal life, and brimming with tales of ancient glaciers, eons of erosion, and millennia of human history.

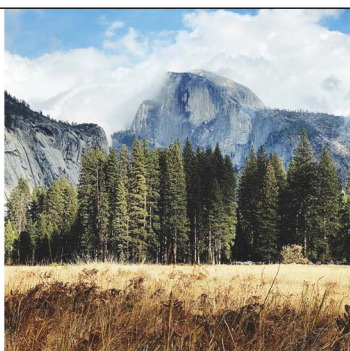

Natural History

Half Dome is easy to spot in Yosemite Valley. Towering over rivers and meadows, it stretches 4,737 feet (1,444 m) from the floor of the Valley to top out at an elevation of 8,844 feet (2,696 m) above sea level.

THE BASICS

You can probably guess the first question most people ask about Half Dome: "What happened to the other half?" Brace yourself: Half Dome is not half a dome. It's closer to 80 percent of a long, sloping bit of rock.

The 1864 Yosemite Grant Act placed Yosemite Valley and the Mariposa Grove of Giant Sequoias under California's governor as the nation's first government-managed land. In 1890, a national park—the country's third—was established to protect land around the Valley and Grove from private development. (These two areas were added to Yosemite National Park in 1909.)

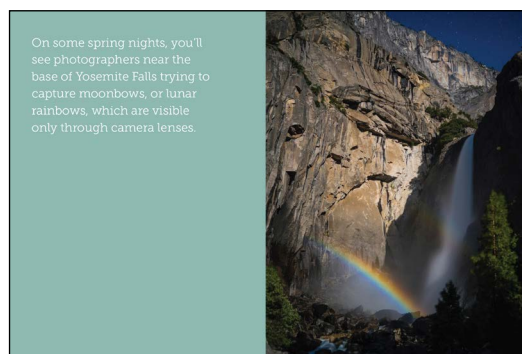
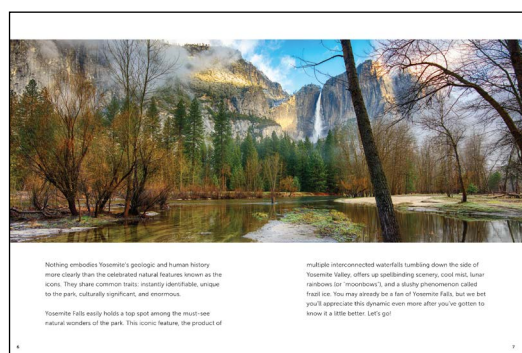
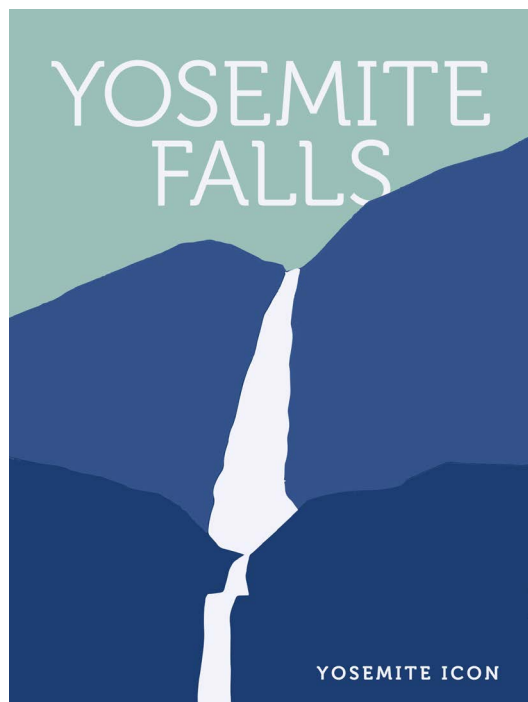


This public-lands legislation gathered in an era of tourism, conservation, and federal management. Some Native people still lived among the mushrooming non-Native population, often working for the National Park Service (NPS) as they could stay in their ancestral home. The NPS demolished the last Native village

in the Valley in the 1950s, but today Yosemite's seven affiliated tribes regularly consult on matters relating to the park and hold events within its borders. For more on Native history, practices, and ongoing presence in the Yosemite area, read *Voices of the People* (see Resources, p. XX).
