PAINTING AND PRINTMAKING

This class meets at the **Happy Isles Art and Nature Center**, near shuttle stop 16! We'll meet inside Happy Isles and spend four hours creating art together in Yosemite Valley.

Please arrive between **8:30 AM** and **8:45 AM**. Class begins at **9 AM**. The class will be both indoors and outdoors, we will draw and paint leaves outdoors and print them indoors. All locations are accessible by a short walk or bus ride from Happy Isles Art and Nature Center. If you require special accommodations, please let us know: art@yosemite.org.

Materials and supplies are provided for this class. Yosemite Conservancy will provide all painting and printmaking supplies.

If you would like to bring or purchase your own supplies, this list is a good place to start.

ART SUPPLIES TO BRING

- HB or 2B pencil, vinyl eraser, and sharpener
- Watercolor paper, 140 lb. cold press sketchbook
- Watercolor brushes, minimum of 1 round (#8 - #12) and 1 flat (¾"-1"), or use water brushes instead of traditional brushes
- Watercolor paints, pan set or tubes in a palette (paints need to be small and portable with a mixing palette)
- Micron pens (size 03 or 05), or other waterproof drawing pens

EQUIPMENT & GEAR TO BRING

- Water bottle for drinking water
- Weather appropriate attire
- Sunscreen/hat
- Lunch/snacks (class does not break for lunch)

PROVIDED MATERIALS, AS NEEDED

- Easel
- Stool
- Hardboard
- Water cup
