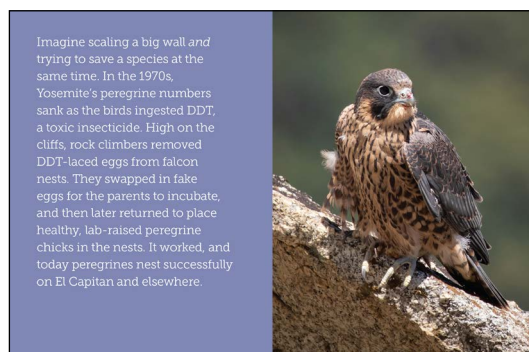
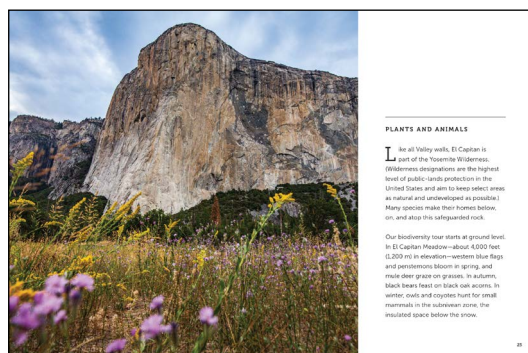

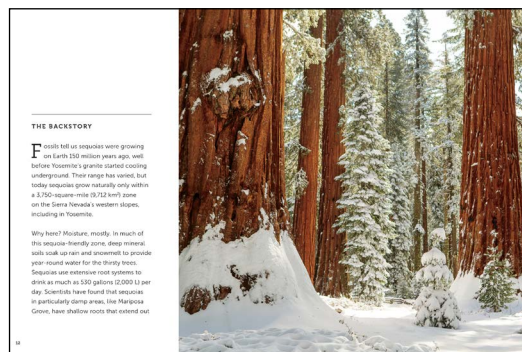


Natural History

Giant sequoias (*Sequoiadendron giganteum*) are part of a group of conifers commonly called redwoods, for their russet trunks. Along with giant sequoias, which are native to California's Sierra Nevada range, the redwood group includes just two other living species: the pyramid-shaped, relatively petite dawn redwood from China, which drops its leaves seasonally, and the coast redwood, the world's tallest tree, which is native to the U.S. West Coast.

Giant sequoias are among Earth's largest living things. A mature sequoia can be more than 100 feet (30 m) wide and 300 feet (90 m) tall, and it can weigh more than a pair of blue whales. 50 abies, sequoias, or 8,500 adult humans. And healthy sequoias keep growing. Larger, older sequoias tend to gain more

wood each year than smaller trees do because they have more leaves, which means a greater capacity to photosynthesize. On lots of the world's largest living sequoias, the Grizzly Giant in Yosemite's Mariposa Grove, currently ranks twenty-fifth or twenty-sixth. It's very big.



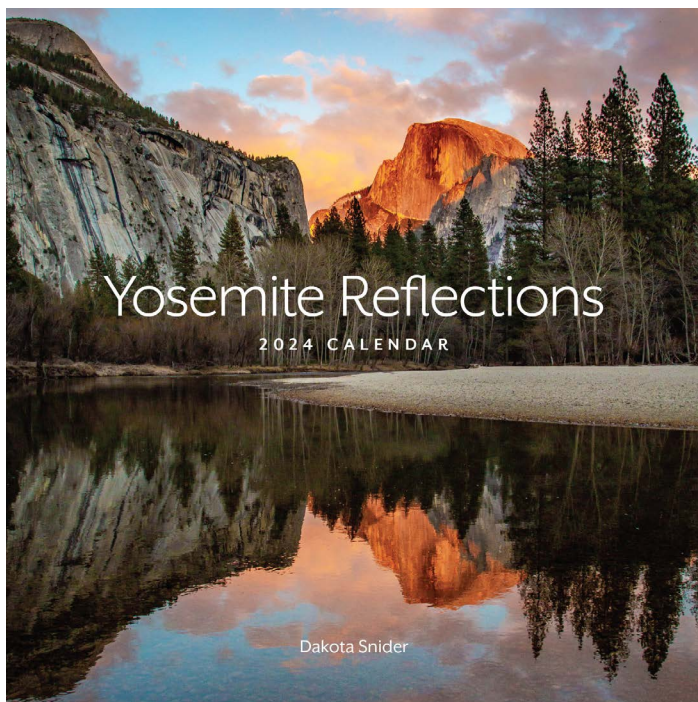
THE BACKSTORY

Fossils tell us sequoias were growing on Earth 550 million years ago, well before Yosemite's granite canyons, soaring underground. Their range has varied, but today sequoias grow naturally only within a 3,750-square-mile (9,724 km²) zone on the Sierra Nevada's western slopes, including in Yosemite.

Why here? Moisture, mostly. In much of this sequoia-friendly zone, deep mineral soils soak up rain and groundwater to provide year-round water for the thirsty trees. Sequoias use extensive root systems to drink as much as 500 gallons (2,000 L) per day. Scientists have found that sequoias in particularly damp areas, like Mariposa Grove, have shallow roots that extend out

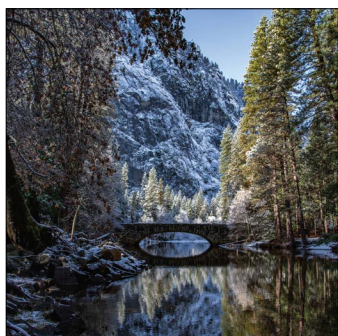
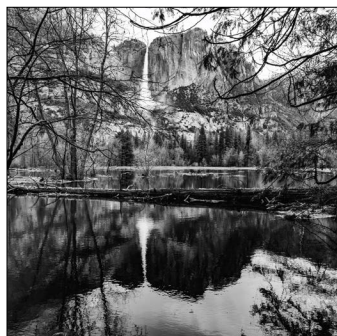
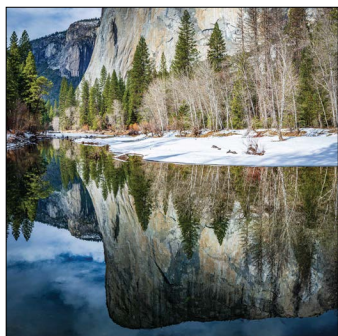
- Mighty El Capitan, reflected in the Merced River.
