ART SUPPLIES TO BRING

- HB pencil, vinyl eraser, and sharpener
- Watercolor paper: 140lb cold press (pad, block, notebook or individual sheets)
- Watercolor brushes: minimum of 1 round (#8 - #12) and 1 flat (¾"-1")
- Watercolor paints (pan set or tubes) & mixing palette
- Your favorite pens to write or draw with – micron pens, calligraphy pens, brush pens, etc. These fun tools will inspire the written poetry you'll create during class!
