WATERCOLOR & INK

This class starts at [Happy Isles Art and Nature Center](#), near shuttle stop 16! We'll meet inside Happy Isles and spend four hours creating art together in Yosemite Valley.

Please arrive between **8:30 AM** and **8:45 AM** to purchase your supplies (if needed) and get settled in. Class begins at **9 AM**, when the group will head out to create art *en plein air*. ART SUPPLIES TO BRING

- HB or 2B pencil, vinyl eraser, and sharpener
- Watercolor paper, 140 lb. cold press sketchbook
- Watercolor brushes: 1 round (#8 - #12) and 1 flat (¾"-1"), or use water brushes instead of traditional brushes
- Watercolor paints: pan set or tubes squeezed and dried in a palette. Your paint set should be small and portable with a mixing palette. We recommend primary colors (magenta or red, blue, and yellow) as well as some earth tones (greens and browns)
- Micron pens (size 03 or 05)

** Materials and supplies are available for rent or purchase on the day of your class if needed.

- Water bottle for drinking water

- Sunscreen, hat, & bug repellent
