

SAMPLE BACKPACK & PAINT ITINERARY

Art Retreats are planned for your enjoyment and safety. This sample itinerary serves as an idea to help you understand what to expect. Please note:

- Participants are responsible for attending the Pre-Trip Meeting so that they are aware of trip logistics, emergency protocols, and trailhead location.
- The agreed-upon retreat schedule may change due to safety, weather, or other concerns. Changes will always be communicated to retreat participants.
- Retreat instructors may alter the schedule to incorporate sunrise or sunset painting into the schedule (if all retreat members are interested). If the day begins early for sunrise (or vice versa), the instruction period will conclude accordingly.

DAY ONE

12–5 pm	Arrive at campground and set up tents for
	the evening.
5:30–6:30 pm	Pre-Trip Meeting: Art Programs staff will
	provide an overview of Leave No Trace
	principles, safety tips, and discuss painting
	locations for the following three days.
6:30 pm	Eat dinner, settle in for the evening, and get
	to bed early!

DAY TWO

9– 10 am	Meet at the trailhead. Remove all scented
	items from vehicles and place them inside
	bear boxes at the trailhead parking area.
10 am	Begin hiking out to our wilderness camping
	spot! Hike at group pace and take breaks as
	needed.
1 pm	Arrive at our camping spot, set up tents, and
	settle in. Eat lunch if you haven't already.
2–4:30 pm	Enjoy some light watercolor instruction and
	exercises!
5 pm	Return to camp, make dinner, and enjoy the
	evening.

DAY THREE

8 am	Eat breakfast and prepare for the day.
9 am-4:30 pm	Hike out to painting location for the day.
	Bring snacks and lunch with you!
5 pm	Return to camp, make dinner, and enjoy the
	evening.

DAY FOUR

5–7 am	Gather for sunrise painting.
7–8:30 am	Return to campsite, eat breakfast, and
	prepare for the day ahead.
8:30 am–12 pm	Enjoy some light watercolor instruction and
	exercises!
12– 1 pm	Eat lunch and pack up campsite/gear.
1–3:30 pm	Hike out to the trailhead parking area.
4 pm	Backpack and paint retreat concludes. All
	participants have the option to camp at the
	designated campground for the evening.

DAY FIVE

11 am	All participants who opted to camp an extra
	night must check out of the campground.
