## SUGGESTED GEAR LIST

## WHAT TO WEAR

Dress for mountain conditions, which means it could be stormy or warm, or both. The program continues rain or shine, so come prepared for any weather with layered clothing and waterproof outerwear, as well as sturdy footwear. Do not wear cotton. If it looks to be a cold or wet day, remember a warm hat, gloves and consider extra socks! Sun protection will be very important if it's clear. It can get very warm while traveling, and cool when not. You will want to be able to shed layers. Be sure to check the weather before you come to be sure you are fully prepared.

## **EQUIPMENT & GEAR TO BRING**

- Daypack with lunch and water for the whole day-at least 2 liters
- Sunscreen, sun hat, and sunglasses
- Rain gear and bug spray
- Waterproof shoes/boots
- Restrooms-there will be some locations with bathrooms but not everywhere. When there are no restrooms you will be using the woods. All trash must be packed out; bring a plastic bag for this.

Materials list:

**Portable Easel** (French, Guerilla, Open M or other)

**Palette** - part of easel setup or use disposable

Canvases: or canvas boards, 8x10, 9x12 or 11x14 --2, 3 per day

**Brushes:** a variety of four to six flat, filbert and round, sizes 3-6

**Paint:** 

Titanium White

Naples Yellow

Cadmium Yellow (warm)

Azo or Lemon Yellow (cool)

Burnt Sienna

Cadmium or other (warm) red

Alizarin Crimson, Rose Madder or other (cool) red

Ultramarine Blue (warm)

Cerulean or Pthalo Blue (cool)

Optional (shortcut colors): Burnt Umber, Raw Sienna, Paynes Gray, Sap or Hookers green

Optional: portable stool, umbrella

**Thinner and Medium:** Gamsol, Turpenoid or another odorless thinner, Liquin, linseed oil or Neo Magilp medium as desired

Paper towels and extra Ziploc bags
